The Board of Education shall exercise its executive power in part by the appointment of a Superintendent, who shall enforce the statutes of the State of New Jersey, rules of the State Board of Education, and policies of this Board.

The Superintendent shall prepare regulations for the administration of the school district that are not inconsistent with statutes or rules of the State Board of Education and are dictated by the policies of this Board. Administrative regulations shall be binding upon the employees of this district and the pupils of these schools when issued and shall be provided to the Board at the Board's next meeting. The Board reserves the right to overrule any administrative regulation.

The Superintendent shall have a seat on the Board and shall have the right to speak on all educational matters at meetings of the Board, but shall have no vote.
